

WHY SAGE?

- SAGE (Student Assessment of Growth and Excellence) tests measure Utah's more challenging standards in Math, English language arts, and Science.
- SAGE tests are different from CRTs. Results from Spring 2014 serve as a new baseline for students, teachers and schools.
- SAGE results cannot be compared to former CRT scores.

WHAT IS THE SAGE ASSESSMENT?

- SAGE is an online test designed to measure whether students are meeting the state's higher expectations for college- and career-readiness.
- SAGE measures the full range of grade-level knowledge and skills. Students are writing, constructing math equations, building graphs, and conducting experiments on the computer.
- By comparison, the CRTs measured old standards and focused
- on student recall via multiple choice questions. Therefore, **SAGE and CRT results** cannot be compared.


HOW ARE SAGE RESULTS REPORTED?

SAGE test results are expressed in percent of students scoring as proficient in English language arts, math and science. Proficient means that a student has a strong understanding of challenging content.

Proficiency levels indicate the student's progress towards College and Career Readiness (CCR)


Scale Scores vs. Proficiency Levels

- Scale scores indicate the individual level of what a student knows and is able to do.
- Proficiency levels interpret the scale score into categories: Highly Proficient, Proficient, Approaching Proficient, and Below Proficient.




