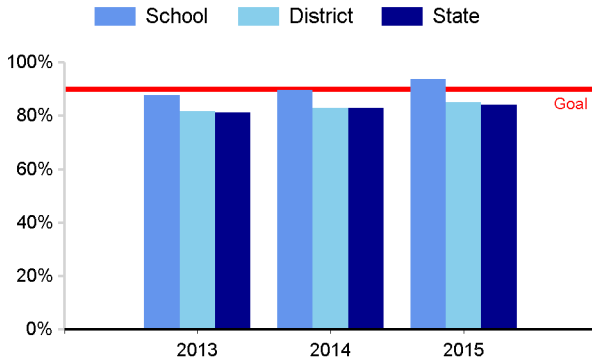

### Graduation Rate



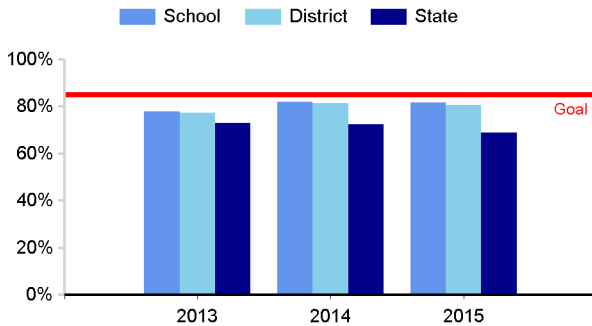

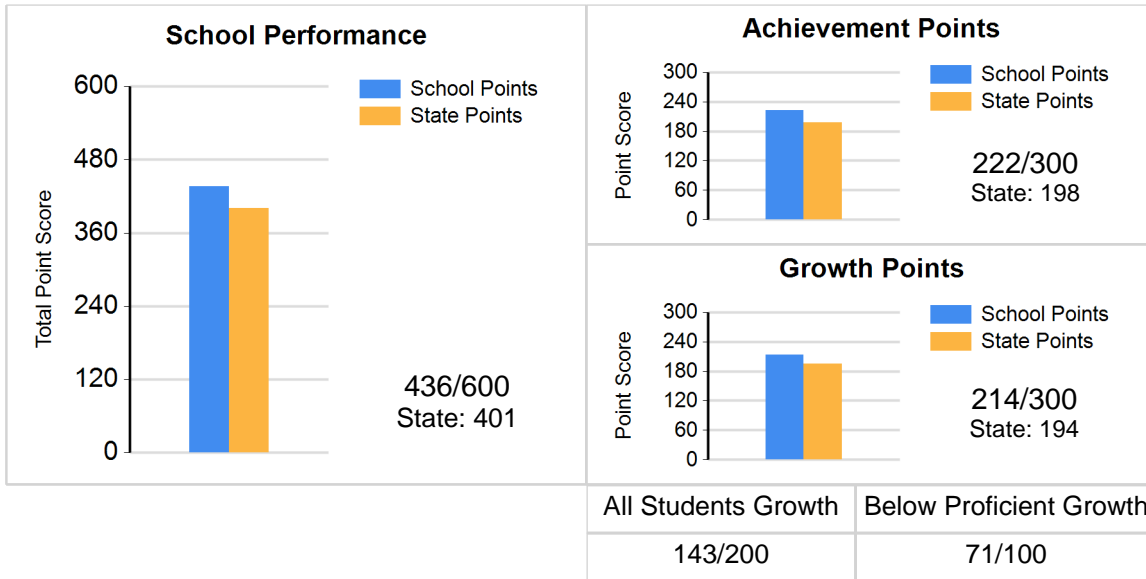
