M+ Applicant Requirements

- Licensed K-12 Teacher working in Canyons District
- At least 2 years of teaching experience
- Will be teaching or have access to ELs
- Able to Attend Face-to-Face (F2F) Meetings of Hybrid M+ courses
- Complete all ESL courses in set timeframe: June 12, 2018–May 10, 2019
- Commitment to Issues of Educational Equity & Diversity

The Canyons District Subsidy

Conditions of Receiving Subsidy

- Abide by Canyons District Code of Conduct
- Reimburse Canyons District for Subsidy provided if choose to Withdraw prior to completion of ESL Endorsement.
- Remain employed by Canyons District for at least a year post completion of M+ ESL Endorsement or repay subsidy (exceptions and/or appeals can be requested).
- If no ELs in classroom, must arrange with principal for face-to-face contact with ELs throughout program (before or after school tutoring, access to different classroom, adding ELs, etc)

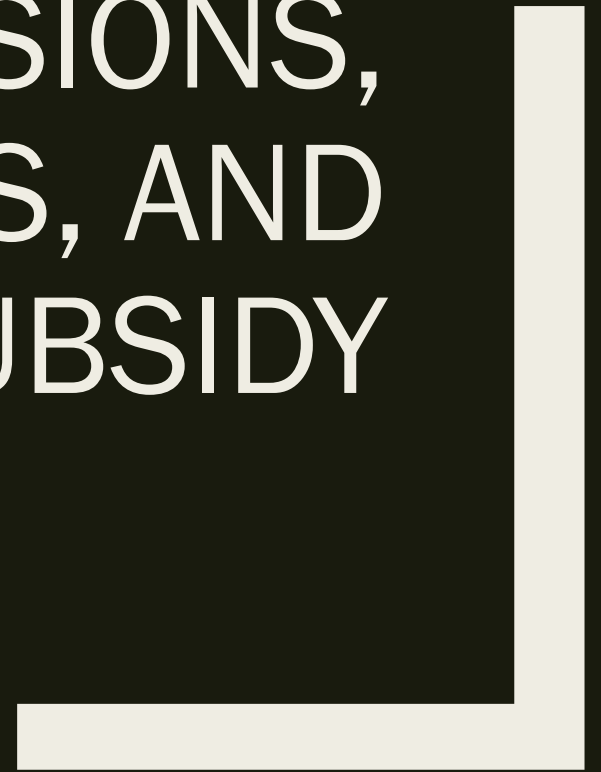
- 10 course (30 credit hour) program

 - 2 courses (6 credit hours) of your choice from available offerings in the ECS department
 - 1 course (3 credit hours) completed through a MED comprehensive exam.

Financial Aid Options

- To qualify for federal, state, and college **financial aid for graduate** school, you have to submit the **FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal **Student Aid**).
- You will need to apply for 2018-19 FAFSA (Spring & Summer 2019) & 2019-20 FAFSA (Fall 2019)
- Website: <https://fafsa.ed.gov/>
- **Students** attending **graduate** school or professional school can borrow up to \$20,500 per year in **Direct Unsubsidized Loans**. The aggregate (cumulative) **loan limit** is \$138,500, including undergraduate debt (and no more than \$65,500 in **Direct Subsidized Loans**).
