UFA Disclosure Statement - Exhibit

Canyons District is an approved provider for families who have received the Utah Fits All Scholarship (UFA). Under state law, UFA students are not considered public school students. They are accessing program(s) provided at a public school and have limited access to public school services.

Please be advised of the following provisions related to accessing Canyons District schools/programs through the use of this scholarship:

- 1. It is the UFA recipients' responsibility to ensure the appropriate fees are paid through ClassWallet according to the fee schedule below.
- 2. UFA students must either show proof of required immunizations or present a waiver as per the state immunization guidelines.
- 3. UFA students are not eligible for transportation services (this does not include transportation related to extracurricular sports/activities/programs/course related field trips).
- 4. UFA students are not eligible for the federally subsidized school lunch program. If a UFA student chooses to eat in a school cafeteria the cost is \$3.00 for breakfast and \$5.00 for lunch and must be paid through Skyward.
- 5. UFA students will not be issued any school/district technology. However, they may rent a Chromebook from their school of choice for \$75.00/year.
- 6. UFA students are not eligible to receive 504 accommodations or Individualized Education Plans (special education services). However, parents may request to have their student evaluated for accommodations and services free of charge. They can also enroll full-time in a Canyons District school at any time, which would make them eligible for accommodation and services.
- 7. UFA students are not eligible to take advantage of concurrent enrollment as per state code (53E-10-301).
- 8. UFA students are not eligible for any state sponsored testing including the end-of-year exams RISE and ASPIRE, or the school's administration of the statewide ACT. They may only access assessments specific to the course in which they are enrolled.
- 9. UFA students are responsible for any fees associated with a class or activity, including class fees, athletic fees, field trip fees, etc. UFA students may not apply for a fee waiver. However, students may participate in fundraising activities associated with the sport or activity in which they are participating. Grading and progress monitoring will be recorded in Skyward and parents will have access.
- 10. UFA students will be graded under the same parameters as other students enrolled in the same course of study for any academic course in which they are enrolled and are expected to attend and participate. Attendance and grading expectations will be consistent with those in place for all students.
- 11. Elementary students will be assigned one teacher of record.
- 12. For supervisory reasons, UFA students may only be on a school campus during the hours for which they are accessing programs or activities. Elementary students may only access school programs during 30-minute increments. The chosen timeframes will be consistent each day and will not vary based on specific daily programming.
- 13. Other resources and programs not specifically listed, which are available to students enrolled in public schools, may not be available to UFA students (i.e. guidance counseling services, school mentoring, etc.)

UFA Fee Schedule

Grades 6-12

- \$250 per quarter of credit
- \$500 per semester per class
- \$1,000 per class per year
- \$250 per Canyons Virtual Academy course
- \$75 Chromebook fee per year
- \$2,000 per Canyons Technical Education Center course, or \$4,000 for year-long courses, plus any required fees.

 Grades K-5 The price for elementary school enrollment is \$600 annually for every 30 minutes of daily attendance. If a student attends school for one hour daily, that equates to \$1,200 for the year. If a student attends two hours daily, the fee would be \$2,400 for the year.
