Items That Do Not Require a Procurement Process Finding

## **Purpose:**

The purpose of this finding is to define items that can be obtained without a procurement process.

## **Definitions:**

63G-6a-103(62). - "Public entity" means the state or any other government entity within the state that expends public funds.

63G-6a-103(55) - "Procurement item" means an item of personal property, a technology, a service, or a construction project.

## Finding:

Pursuant to Utah Code Section 63G-6a-303(5), the Chief Procurement Officer has determined that the following items do not meet the definition of a "procurement item" as defined in Utah Code 63G-6a-103 and, as such, are not subject to the requirements of the Utah Procurement Code 63G-6a and do not require a "procurement process" be conducted. Canyons School District Schools and Departments do not need to submit a sole source request for approval to Purchasing for the items listed below. A requisition, however, will be required for purchases over \$5,000 (See Purchasing Threshold Guidelines):

- 1. Professional or Trade Certification or Recertification Training that is required to obtain the knowledge, experience, and skill to perform the job or tasks associated with the employee's current position
- 2. Conference registration
- 3. Contracts and purchases between other Utah governmental entities
- 4. Musical & Movie royalty rights
- 5. Amusement park entrance fee (i.e. Lagoon, Disney Park, Knotts Berry Farm)
- 6. Professional Association Membership dues and fees (i.e. NHS, IB, HOSA, UHSAA)
- 7. Any fee <u>required</u> for State, Regional and National competitions (i.e. DECA, FCCLA, Cheer, Drill, Athletics, Robotics, FBLA, NASSP, Performing Arts, NHS, Varsity, etc.)
