6. Reorganization of Board Leadership – Leon Wilcox, Business Administrator

A. Reorganization of Board Leadership

Mr. Wilcox conducted the meeting for the purpose of reorganizing the Board leadership. He reviewed the Board Policy, 100.01 Board Governance, regarding board elections and the procedures to be followed for the election process. The policy states the first Board Business meeting in January following a general election, a President and Vice President are elected to serve a two-year term. The Board may appoint other officers from time to time following established procedure according to Utah Code.

<u>MOTION:</u> Andrew Edtl moved to approve two Vice Presidents for Board Leadership. Karen Pedersen seconded the motion. *

There was a discussion to the motion about the advantages and disadvantages of one vice president versus two vice presidents.

To be elected an officer, a nominee must receive a majority of the votes. Candidates for an office shall be voted on according to the order of nominations. A. Industry Focus Group Report – Susan Edwards, Public Engagement Coordinator and Pat Jones, Consultant

The Board of Education has spent a great deal of time researching current educational models and student opportunities in several places in and out of the state. The planning for the Canyons Innovation Center is providing a unique window of opportunity for industry leaders to partner with the District. The focus and research groups provided clear direction that the traditional model of education will not serve students attending the innovation center. The educational model needs to be based on experimentation, curiosity, cooperation, teamwork and learning to grow through failure. Feedback from industry leaders revealed that students are lacking in communication skills, critical thinking skills, collaboration skills, creativity, entrepreneurship, and a basic

understanding of the expectations of a work environment, such as showing up to do the work. Next steps include a continuation of meetings with industry leaders, design decisions, hiring a director, selecting an educational model, determining offerings, and deciding how to partnership with industry and higher education.  C. Strategic Plan Focus Group Report: High Quality Learning – Dr. Amber Roderick Landward, Director of ISD

The High-Quality Learning committee has been spending their time discussing how to narrow and prioritize critical projects and key deliverables. AVID provides an evidence-based, student-centered framework for college and career readiness that aligns with the district strategic plan. In addition, it creates coherence with other district frameworks, prioritized rigor and inquiry as well as increase the durability of District tenets. The implementation will take time, requires commitment, and focus on all levels, realignment of current systems will need to be made and additional resources will be needed, such as annual membership fees and start up resource package. The committee recommends administration consult with AVID to develop a comprehensive implementation plan and formally propose or present an update to the Board by fall of 2025. Next steps will include developing a more detailed timeline for the prioritized project and continue to explore a districtwide model of AVID implementation.
